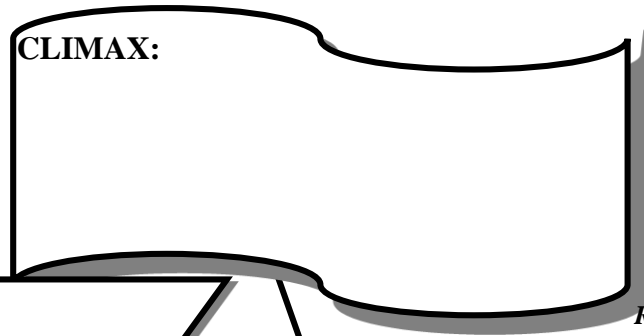

# Plot Diagram Definitions

- **Theme =**
  - The lesson or message of the story
- **Setting/ Exposition =**
  - The beginning of the story
  - The setting or situation where the story takes place
- **Rising Action =**
  - Actions and conflicts in the story that build up to the climax
  - The plot is mostly comprised of the rising action
  - The rising action is the reason why readers want to continue to read your story
- **Main Conflict =**
  - The main problem or struggle in the story
- **Climax =**
  - The turning point in the story
  - Most intense moment of action or emotion
- **Falling Action/ Resolution =**
  - Actions that bring a conclusion
  - Leaves the readers feeling satisfied
- **Characters =**
  - People in the story
